Eligible

- RRFS members working in EAN member countries with more than 2 years of clinical training, up to a maximum of 5 years beyond their final degree (PhD, MD, or equivalent) at the time of application.
- RRFS members from Corresponding Institutional Member Countries (Algeria, Egypt,

Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Mauretania, Morocco, Nepal, Palestine, Tunisia, Syria) and HINARI Group A countries are welcome to apply.

- Application for a travel grant is possible for members working in low and lower-middle income countries. A short letter of intent must be provided.
- Awardees from previous years are no more qualified.

All applicants must be Full member or RRFS member at time of application.

Application for RRFS membership must be started ideally 4 weeks before application deadline.
