

- Speaker picture from the presentation management system or live camera picture if live presentation
- Session details (session room, time, title, chair(s)) as automatic overlay from M Events system
- Talk details (speaker name, talk title) as automatic overlay from M Events system
- Automated webcast for OnDemand section will be produced and available after the live session (if booked via EAN)

Participant view – live stream | Embedding own industry pre-recordings



## Remarks:

- Own presentation pre-recordings in PIP view will be shown in full screen ppt mode without overlaying session and talk details from M Events system
- Speaker picture from the presentation management system will not be shown if speaker video/photo is included in pre-recording mp4 file
- Pre-Recording should fit to the FullHD dimension of the live player (1920 x 1080 px, see orange framed area)
- Session details should be included in pre recording file(s)
- We recommend to prepare 1 file per presentation (mp4 need to be uploaded to presentation management system, max. 5 GB per presentation)
- Live parts for introducing the presentation(s), Q&A between talks and/or in the end of the session can be integrated, all present speakers and chair(s) will be shown with their live webcams (zoom on action controlled from livestream room technician, agenda with instructions needed)
- Automated webcast for OnDemand section will be produced (if booked via EAN). Manual embedding/adjustment can be booked.
