- RRFS members working in EAN member countries with more than 2 years of clinical training, up to a maximum of 5 years beyond their final degree (PhD, MD, or equivalent) at the time of application.
- RRFS members from Corresponding Institutional Member Countries (Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Mauritania, Morocco, Nepal, Palestine, Tunisia, Syria) and HINARI Group A countries are welcome to apply.

- Application for a travel grant is possible for members working in low and lower-middle income countries. A short letter of intent must be provided.
- Awardees from previous years are no more qualified.

All applicants must be Full member or RRFS member at time of application.

Application for RRFS membership must be started well in advance, e.g. 4 weeks before application deadline.
